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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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14	<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 1. Disclosure of information <u>LEGISLATIVE FINDING</u> large predators. (1)
15	Except for information that is required by law to be reported to state or federal officials, the department may not
16	disclose any information that identifies any person who has lawfully taken a large predator as defined in 87-1-217
17	during a hunt without the written consent of the person affected. Information that may not be disclosed includes
18	but is not limited to a person's name, address, phone number, date of birth, social security number, and driver's
19	license number.
20	(2) The legislature finds that the prohibition on disclosure of information pursuant to
21	SUBSECTION (1) IS NECESSARY TO PROTECT AN INDIVIDUAL'S PRIVACY, SAFETY, AND WELFARE.

23	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
24	integral part of Title 87, chapter 1, and the provisions of Title 87, chapter 1, apply to [section 1].
