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17	Section 1. Section 80-7-106, MCA, is amended to read:
18	"80-7-106. License required application and payment of license fee exemption. (1) (a) A
19	Except as provided in subsection (1)(b), a firm, nursery, or plant dealer, OR SMALL PLANT VENDOR engaging in the
20	business of selling or distributing nursery stock in this state shall obtain a license from the department. If the firm,

5	(C) A FIRM, NURSERY, PLANT DEALER, OR SMALL PLANT VENDOR THAT IS NOT REQUIRED TO OBTAIN A LICENSE
6	PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (1)(B)(III) SHALL PROVIDE ITS ADDRESS OR PRIMARY BUSINESS LOCATION AND THE NAME AND
7	CONTACT INFORMATION OF ITS PRINCIPAL CONTACT PERSON TO THE DEPARTMENT.
8	(2) The license must be in the name of the firm, nursery, or plant dealer, OR SMALL PLANT VENDOR seeking
9	the license and expires on the anniversary date established by rule by the board of review established in
10	30-16-302. The applicant shall provide information that the department finds necessary to carry out the provisions
11	and purposes of this chapter and in the form determined by rule by the board of review established in 30-16-302.
12	(3) A small plant vendor must be licensed but is exempt from the license fee requirements of this section.
13	(4)(3) (a) A firm, nursery, or plant dealer, OR SMALL PLANT VENDOR that earns AT LEAST \$1,000 BUT less
14	than \$1,000 \$5,000 in gross annual sales of nursery stock must be licensed but is exempt from licensing fees.
15	(b) A firm, nursery, or plant dealer that earns \$1,000 but less than \$3,000 in gross annual sales of
16	nursery stock shall pay a license fee of \$50 \$25.
17	(c)(b) A firm, nursery, or plant dealer, OR SMALL PLANT VENDOR that earns \$3,000 but less than \$10,000
18	\$5,000 or more in gross annual sales of nursery stock shall pay a license fee of \$125 \$95 \$100.
19	(d) A firm, nursery, or plant dealer that earns \$10,000 or more in gross annual sales of nursery stock
20	shall pay a license fee of \$160.
21	(5)(4) The department may seek verification from the department of revenue as to whether a firm,
22	nursery, or plant dealer, OR SMALL PLANT VENDOR has met the income thresholds established in this section have
23	been met .
24	(6)(5) A new applicant or a firm, nursery, or plant dealer, OR SMALL PLANT VENDOR failing to renew a
25	license on or before the annual anniversary date provided for in subsection (2) shall pay an additional
26	nonrefundable late fee of \$25 for each license.
27	(7)(6) The fees required by the provisions of this section may be paid by credit card and may be
28	discounted for payment processing charges paid by the department to a third party."

 $\textbf{Section 2.} \ \ \textbf{Section 80-7-108, MCA, is amended to read:}$



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1	"80-7-108. Nursery stock inspection fees. (1) The department:
2	(a) may enter the premises of a licensed firm, nursery, or plant dealer, or of a small plant vendor during
3	regular business hours for the purpose of inspecting nursery stock or other materials for possible plant pests o
4	for determining licensure compliance. An inspection fee may not be assessed if the department requests the
5	inspection.; and
6	(b) shall, pursuant to rules promulgated by the department, determine the schedule, and THE need for
7	inspections based on complaints received and the department's assessment of risk to the state from potential
8	plant pests, AND THE EXPECTED AMOUNT OF TIME FOR THE INSPECTIONS.
9	(2) (a) A firm, nursery, plant dealer, or small plant vendor may request the inspection of nursery stock
0	plants, or other materials by giving the department 5 days' notice prior to the time when the nursery stock, plants
1	or other materials are ready for inspection. A firm, nursery, plant dealer, or small plant vendor requesting ar
2	inspection shall pay a fee of not less than \$42 per hour and not more than \$50 per hour as established by
3	department rule.
4	(b) A firm, nursery, plant dealer, or small plant vendor may not be charged a fee for an inspection of
5	nursery stock, plants, or other materials if the inspection is initiated by the department under the department's
6	authority.
7	(c) The fee imposed in subsection (2)(a) FIRM, NURSERY, PLANT DEALER, OR SMALL PLANT VENDOR SHALL
8	PAY A FEE TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR AN INSPECTION CONDUCTED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION. THE FEE must cover the
9	actual costs of inspection, surveys, and other services required to issue the plant inspection certificate
20	PERFORMED BY THE DEPARTMENT AND MAY NOT BE LESS THAN \$42 PER HOUR OR MORE THAN \$50 PER HOUR AS
21	ESTABLISHED BY DEPARTMENT RULE.
22	(3) The department may issue a plant inspection certificate based on the results of a nursery stock o
23	other plant inspection or inspection survey."
