4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REVISING MONTANA GRIZZLY BEAR POLICY TO AVOID
5	CONFLICTS WITH HUMANS AND LIVESTOCK; AMENDING SECTION 87-5-301, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN
6	IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
9	
10	Section 1. Section 87-5-301, MCA, is amended to read:
11	<b>87-5-301.</b> Policy toward grizzly Grizzly bear findings policy. (1) The legislature finds that:
12	(a) grizzly bears are a recovered population and thrive under responsive cooperative management;
13	(b) grizzly bear conservation is best served under state management and the local, state, tribal, and
14	federal partnerships that fostered recovery; and
15	(c) successful conflict management is key to maintaining public support for conservation of the grizzly
16	bear.
17	(2) It is hereby declared the policy of the state of Montana to: protect, conserve, and
18	(a) manage the grizzly bear as a rare species of Montana wildlife to avoid conflicts with humans and
19	livestock; and
20	(b) use preemptive management to control grizzly bear distribution and prevent conflicts, including
21	trapping and lethal measures."

23	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
