9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	Section 1. Section 25-13-609, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"25-13-609. Personal property exempt subject to value limitations. A judgment debtor is entitled to
13	exemption from execution of the following:
14	(1) the judgment debtor's interest, not to exceed \$4,500 in aggregate value, to the extent of a value not
15	exceeding \$600 in any item of property, in household furnishings and goods, appliances, jewelry, wearing
16	apparel, books, firearms and other sporting goods, animals, feed, crops, and musical instruments, and money
17	and funds on deposit with a bank, savings and loan association, credit union, or similar financial institution;
18	(2) the judgment debtor's interest, not to exceed \$2,500 in value, in one motor vehicle; and
19	(3) the judgment debtor's interest, not to exceed \$3,000 in aggregate value, in any implements,
20	professional books, and tools, of the trade of the judgment debtor or a dependent of the judgment debtor."

22	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.

24	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Applicability. [This act] applies to executions of judgment in actions
25	resulting in judgment filed on or after [the effective date of this act].
