6	COUNTIES IN WHICH A UNIVERSITY SYSTEM CAMPUS IS LOCATED AND THE MOTORCYCLE SAFE		
7	ADVISORY COMMITTEE; AMENDING SECTION 20-25-301, MCA; REPEALING SECTIONS 20-25-30		
8	20-25-304, AND 20-25-1004, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:		
11			
12	Section 1. Section 20-25-301, MCA, is amended to read:		
13	"20-25-301. Regents' powers and duties. The board of regents of higher education shall serve as		
14	regents of the Montana university system, shall use and adopt this style in all its dealings with the universit		
15	system, and:		
16	(1) must have general control and supervision of the units of the Montana university system, which is		
17	considered for all purposes one university;		
18	(2) shall adopt rules for its own government that are consistent with the constitution and the laws of the		
19	state and that are proper and necessary for the execution of the powers and duties conferred upon it by law;		
20	(3) shall provide, subject to the laws of the state, rules for the government of the system;		
21	(4) shall grant diplomas and degrees to the graduates of the system upon the recommendation of the		
22	faculties and have discretion to confer honorary degrees upon persons other than graduates upon the		
23	recommendation of the faculty of the institutions;		
24	(5) shall keep a record of its proceedings;		
25	(6) must have, when not otherwise provided by law, control of all books, records, buildings, grounds, and		
26	other property of the system;		
27	(7) must receive from the board of land commissioners, from other boards or persons, or from the		
28	government of the United States all funds, income, and other property that the system may be entitled to and use		
29	and appropriate the property for the specific purpose of the grant or donation;		
30	(8) must have general control of all receipts and disbursements of the system;		

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ı	(9) 5112	in appoint a president of charicellor and faculty for each of the institutions of the system, appoint	
2	any other necessary officers, agents, and employees, and fix their compensation;		
3	(10) shall confer upon the executive board of each of the units of the system authority that may be		
4	considered expedient relating to immediate control and management, other than authority relating to finance		
5	matters or the selection of the teachers, employees, and faculty;		
6	(11)(10) shall confer, at the regents' discretion, upon the president and faculty of each of the units of		
7	system for the best interest of the unit authority relating to the immediate control and management, other the		
8	financial, and the selection of teachers and employees;		
9	(12)(11) shall prevent unnecessary duplication of courses at the units of the system;		
10	(13)(12) shall appoint a certified professional geologist or registered mining engineer as the director		
11	the Montana state bureau of mines and geology, who is the state geologist, and appoint any other necessar		
12	assistants and employees and fix their compensation;		
13	(14)(13) shall supervise and control the agricultural experiment station, along with any executive		
14	subordinate board or authority that may be appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the regent		
15	(15)(14) shall adopt a seal bearing on its face the words "Montana university system", which must be		
16	affixed to all diplomas and all other papers, instruments, or documents that may require it;		
17	(16)(15) shall ensure an adequate level of security for data, as defined in 2-15-102, within the sta		
18	university system. In carrying out this responsibility, the board of regents shall, at a minimum, address the		
19	responsibilities prescribed in 2-15-114.		
20	(17)(16) shall offer courses in vocational-technical education of a type and in a manner considere		
21	necessary or practical by the regents."
