6	NUMBER OF SIGNATURES ON A PETITION TO AMEND THE MONTANA CONSTITUTION BY INITIATIVE T		
7	20% OF THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE STATE AND TO 20% OF THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS		
8	EACH OF AT LEAST ONE-HALF OF THE COUNTIES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:		
11			
12	Section 1. Article XIV, section 9, of The Constitution of the State of Montana is amended to read:		
13	"Section 9. Amendment by initiative. (1) The people may also propose constitutional amendments		
14	by initiative. Petitions including the full text of the proposed amendment shall be signed by at least ten twent		
15	percent of the qualified electors of the state. That number shall include at least ten twenty percent of the qualified		
16	electors in each of at least one-half of the counties.		
17	(2) The petitions shall be filed with the secretary of state. If the petitions are found to have been signed		
18	by the required number of electors, the secretary of state shall cause the amendment to be published as provide		
19	by law twice each month for two months previous to the next regular state-wide election.		
20	(3) At that election, the proposed amendment shall be submitted to the qualified electors for approval		
21	or rejection. If approved by a majority voting thereon, it shall become a part of the constitution effective the first		
22	day of July following its approval, unless the amendment provides otherwise."

24	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Two-thirds vote required. Because [section 1] is a legislative proposal		
25	to amend the constitution, Article XIV, section 8, of the Montana constitution requires an affirmative roll call vot		
26	of two-thirds of all the members of the legislature, whether one or more bodies, for passage.

28	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. If approved by the electorate, [this act] is effective January		
29	1, 2013.

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1	NEW S	ECTION. Section 4. Submission to electorate. [This act] shall be submitted to the qualified	
2	electors of Mon	tana at the general election to be held in November 2012 by printing on the ballot the full title of	
3	[this act] and the following:

5		by initiative.	
6	[]	AGAINST increasing the minimum number of signatures needed to amend the Montana	
7		constitution by initiative.
