6	PUPIL-INSTRUCTION-RELATED PUPIL-INSTRUCTION DAY AND DOES NOT COUNT TOWARD THE
7	MINIMUM AGGREGATE HOURS OF PUPIL INSTRUCTION; AND AMENDING SECTION 20-1-303, MCA."

9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	Section 1. Section 20-1-303, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"20-1-303. Conduct of school on Saturday or Sunday prohibited exception exceptions. (1)
13	Except as provided in this section subsections (2) and (3), pupil instruction may not be conducted on Saturday
14	or Sunday.
15	(2) In emergencies, pupil instruction may be conducted on a Saturday when it is approved by the trustees
16	of the school district in accordance with the policies adopted by the board of public education.
17	(3) Pupil instruction may be held on a Saturday at the discretion of a school district for the purpose of
18	providing additional pupil instruction, provided that:
19	(a) Saturday school is not a pupil-instruction-related PUPIL-INSTRUCTION day, as defined in 20-1-304 AND
20	DOES NOT COUNT TOWARD MINIMUM AGGREGATE HOURS OF PUPIL INSTRUCTION PROVIDED FOR IN 20-1-301; AND
21	(b) teachers who volunteer to teach on a Saturday are compensated at the same rate as and in addition
22	to their annual contract of employment compensation; and
23	(c)(B) student attendance is voluntary."
