30	30 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 2. Effective date applicability. If approved by the electorate, [this act] is		
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effective January 1, 2013, and applies to budget sessions and regular sessions of the legislature beginning after
 December 31, 2014.

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<u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Section 3. Two-thirds vote required.** Because [section 1] is a legislative proposal to amend the constitution, Article XIV, section 8, of the Montana constitution requires an affirmative roll call vote of two-thirds of all the members of the legislature, whether one or more bodies, for passage.

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NEW SECTION. Section 4. Submission to electorate. [This act] shall be submitted to the qualified electors of Montana at the general election to be held in November 2012 by printing on the ballot the full title of [this act] and the following:
