9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	Section 1. Section 7-35-4102, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"7-35-4102. Vesting of title to cemetery grounds restrictions on use. The title to lands used as
13	a public cemetery or graveyard, situated in or near to any city <del>,</del> or town <del>, or village</del> and used by the inhabitants
14	thereof of the city or town as a burial-ground burial ground continuously without interruption for 5 years, is vested
15	in the inhabitants of $\frac{1}{2}$ city, $\frac{1}{2}$ city, $\frac{1}{2}$ town, or $\frac{1}{2}$ town,
16	a public cemetery, except <u>:</u> that
17	(1) the bodies interred therein in the cemetery grounds may be removed and no other additional bodies
18	may be interred therein in the cemetery grounds upon the order of the board of county commissioners, city
19	council, or other body having authority when it appears that the public health is endangered or for any other good
20	cause <del>, but a</del> . A new cemetery must be purchased and laid out by proper authority and such the bodies removed
21	and from the old cemetery must be interred therein in the new cemetery, and the The old cemetery may be sold
22	and the proceeds applied to the purchase of the new cemetery.
23	(2) when a portion of the cemetery grounds are determined to be unsuitable for the interment of bodies,
24	the unsuitable grounds may be used for another public purpose upon the order of the board of county
25	commissioners, city council, or other body having authority."
