6	A HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFIT BE MADE PUBLIC BY THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES DIVISION;
7	AMENDING SECTION 5-2-303, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	Section 1. Section 5-2-303, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"5-2-303. Participation in state benefits group employer contribution made to other plan. (1)
13	Individual members of the senate and the house of representatives may enroll in the state employees benefits
14	group during the terms to which they have been elected. The provider of benefits shall enroll and collect
15	employee contributions directly from such participating legislators. The employer contribution shall must be paid
16	from funds appropriated for that purpose.
17	(2) (a) If a member does not enroll or terminates enrollment under the state employees benefits group
18	plan and is insured under a plan providing disability insurance as defined in 33-1-207, the department of
19	administration, upon request of the member, shall pay to the member's insurer an amount equal to the premium
20	required to be paid by the member for coverage of the member and any dependents under the disability
21	insurance plan, subject to the limitation contained in subsection (2)(b).
22	(b) A payment made under subsection (2)(a) may not exceed the amount of the employer contribution
23	for group benefits for members of the legislature as provided for in 2-18-703.
24	(3) Upon request, the department of administration shall provide the legislative services division with the
25	current status of each legislator regarding the legislator's choice to participate under either subsection (1) or (2).
26	The legislative services division shall post the name of each legislator and the option chosen UNDER EITHER
27	SUBSECTION (1) OR (2) to their website."
