| 11 | Section 1. Article IV, section 5, of The Constitution of the State of Montana is amended to read: |
| 12 | "Section 5. Result of elections. In (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), in all elections held by the |
| 13 | people, the person or persons receiving the largest number of votes shall be declared elected. |
| 14 | (2) In a general election, a majority of votes is needed in order to be elected." |

| 16 | NEW SECTION. Section 2. Two-thirds vote required. Because [section 1] is a legislative proposal |
| 17 | to amend the constitution, Article XIV, section 8, of the Montana constitution requires an affirmative roll call vote |
| 18 | of two-thirds of all the members of the legislature, whether one or more bodies, for passage. |

| 20 | NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. This amendment is effective on approval by the electorate. |

| 22 | NEW SECTION. Section 4. Submission to electorate. [This act] shall be submitted to the qualified |
| 23 | electors of Montana at the general election to be held in November 2012 by printing on the ballot the full title of |
| 24 | [this act] and the following: |

| 26 | [] AGAINST providing that in a general election, a majority of votes is needed in order to be |
