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10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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12	Section 1. Section 17-8-303, MCA, is amended to read:
13	"17-8-303. Warrants presentation and cancellation. (1) State warrants must be presented for
14	payment within the time limits specified as follows:
15	(a) Except as provided in subsection (1)(b), all warrants drawn by the state treasurer on the state
16	treasury must be presented for payment within 6 months after the date of issue.
17	(b) Warrants issued for the department of public health and human services that are funded to any extent
18	with federal money must be presented for payment within 180 days after the date of issue.
19	(2) If the payee or legal holder of any warrant fails to present it for payment within the time specified in
20	subsection (1), the state treasurer shall record the warrant as stale-dated and the amount must be credited to
21	a separate private purpose trust fund account administered by the treasurer. If the payee or legal owner of a
22	stale-dated warrant presents it for payment or presents a claim for payment within 4 years 1 year from the date
23	of issue, the state treasurer may, upon proper showing by affidavit, issue a new warrant in lieu of the stale-dated
24	warrant.
25	(3) Three years and 6 Six months after being stale-dated, the warrant must be classed as unclaimed
26	property subject to the provisions of Title 70, chapter 9, part 8. If the payee or legal owner of a stale-dated warrant
27	presents it for payment or presents a claim for payment, the presentation must be to the department of revenue
28	as provided in 70-9-815."
