4	A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF
5	MONTANA URGING CONGRESS TO CALL A CONVENTION FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF PROPOSING
6	SUPPORT AN AMENDMENT TO THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION TO REQUIRE A BALANCED
7	FEDERAL BUDGET EXCEPT IN TIMES OF WAR.

9	WHEREAS, Article V of the United States Constitution provides that upon the application of the

11	WHEREAS, the Legislature of Montana deems an amendment for the United States Constitution requiring
12	a balanced federal budget, EXCEPT IN TIMES OF WAR, necessary for the good of the American people.

14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
15	STATE OF MONTANA:
16	That the Legislature of the State of Montana makes application to the Congress under IN ACCORDANCE
17	<u>WITH</u> the provisions of Article V of the United States Constitution to call a convention for the sole purpose of
18	proposing SUPPORTS an amendment to the United States Constitution to require a balanced federal budget,
19	EXCEPT IN TIMES OF WAR, and TO prevent the federal government from appropriating or otherwise spending funds
20	in excess of anticipated revenues.
21	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be dispatched to the Majority Leader of the
22	United States Senate, to the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, to the Secretaries of the
23	United States and Montana Senates, to the Clerks of the United States and Montana Houses of Representatives,
24	to each member of the Montana congressional delegation, and to the presiding officers of each house of the
25	Legislature of each state in the Union requesting their cooperation.
