FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions:

1. This legislation requires the Board of Medical Examiners to collect information regarding the medical workforce through initial applications for licensure and license renewal applications. There will be some minimal rulemaking involved to address requirements and compliance issues if licensees do not provide the required information.
2. The cost to collect the data and store it for the same record retention period that the division currently stores all renewal applications is thought to be minimal.
