Description of fiscal impact: This bill has no fiscal impact to the state.

FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions:

1. HB 465 increases and establishes certain fees charged by county clerks such as filing of subdivision and town-site plats, filing certificates of surveys and amendments, etc. The increases will impact developers and/or property owners that need to file plats and documents with the county clerk and recorders and do not impact DEQ.

Effect on County or Other Local Revenues or Expenditures:

1. HB 465 doubles the filing fee for surveys and amendments to plats and will result in additional revenues to the counties. No estimate of the number of surveys or amendments this legislation would impact was provided to the OBPP.
2. In addition, the bill requires a \$1 fee per page for documents to be recorded with a subdivision, townsite plat, or certificate of survey. No estimate was provided for how many pages per year this legislation would impact and therefore the fiscal impact could not be determined.
