Assumptions:

1. The State Auditors' Office (SAO) cannot estimate how many limited lines travel insurance registries will be filed. Section 2 of the bill states that "the commissioner shall require a fee for filing the registry that is commensurate with the cost of maintaining a file for all registries filed with the commissioner." Any changes in revenue to the SAO as a result of this legislation are expected to be minimal.
2. There will be no additional administrative costs to SAO with this bill.
