### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### Assumptions:

1. With the limited number of nonprofit organizations eligible to arrange these hunts, the Department of Fish Wildlife and Parks (FWP) estimates that 50 to 150 of these donation/reissue licenses would occur yearly.
2. The department's Automated Licensing System (ALS) is already set up to allow cancelation and reissuance of licenses and permits.
3. The nominal time and work needed to implement this could be absorbed in FWP's normal licensing duties.
