FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions:

- The bill authorizes the state agencies to enter into an agreement with a contractor which would allow the state agency to make payments directly to subcontractors. State agencies, however, would not be required to enter into these agreements. It is estimated that these agreements would occur for only a small portion of state contracts. Any cost due to the increased number of payments would be nominal.
