Description of fiscal impact: This legislation requires professional licensing boards to adopt rules to define what type of military training will constitute satisfactory qualification for a license.

FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions:

1. It is estimated that approximately eight licensing boards would be affected by this legislation.
2. The boards will notice rules to implement this legislation. It is estimated there will be a two page rule notice and one page adoption notice for a total of 24 pages filed and published by the Secretary of State. The cost for noticing rules would be \$1,200.
3. The boards will each hold a hearing to allow for public comment. It is estimated the hearing will be an average of two hours in length and will be conducted by a hearings officer and transcribed by a court reporter or transcriptionist. The total cost for hearings would be \$3,520.
4. The boards will send post cards to interested parties directing them to the board's websites for information regarding the rule notice and instructions on how to comment or present oral commentary at the hearing. The cost of sending the post cards would be \$1,200.

5. The total cost for hearings, rules notice, and interested party notification would be \$5,920.
6. The boards affected by this legislation will have enough spending authority in their base budget to cover legal costs associated with implementation.
7. Boards will cover the costs of implementing this legislation through licensing fees commensurate with costs.
