Insert: "(4) (a) A person may not intentionally provide supplemental feed to game animals in a manner that results in artificial concentration of game animals that may potentially contribute to the transmission of disease. A person who violates this subsection shall be fined not less than \$50 or more than \$1,000 or be imprisoned in the county detention center for not more than 6 months, or both. In addition, a person, upon conviction or forfeiture of bond or bail, may be subject to forfeiture of any current hunting,

fishing, or trapping license issued by this state and the privilege to hunt, fish, or trap in this state or to use state land, as defined in 77-1-101, for recreational purposes for a period of time set by the court.

(b) Subsection (4) (a) does not apply to supplemental feeding activities conducted by the department for disease control purposes."
