Explanation - This amendment addresses the issues identified by legal staff in a legal review of HB 2.

1) In the Department of Commerce, the bill citation upon which the appropriation for Weights and Measures equipment is contingent is changed from the LC number to the actual bill number, which was unknown at the time of the first writing of the language.

2) In the Department of Environmental Quality, the bill includes language that give the Planning, Prevention, and Assistance Division the authority to increase federal funds and reduce state special revenue in the drinking water and/or water pollution control revolving loan programs. The amendment identifies the division in the language.

3) In the Department of Justice, the source of funding in FY 2014 for the Division of Criminal Investigation should HB 218 pass was inadvertently left out.
