Explanation - This amendment provides \$1.0 million in long-range information technology program funds for modifications in the Montana Information Technology Act (MITA) that were passed and approved in SB 312. The legislation new principles that are to guide the development of state information technology resources. One principle includes electronic record creation, management, storage, and retrieval processes and procedures that are to be used to create and deliver professional records management. In addition the information technology systems are to be able to embrace the economics of digitized records to avoid duplication and transport costs. The changes in MITA were recommended by the Select Committee on Efficiency in Government.
