In regards to HB 247 to allow permits to salvage certain game accidentally killed by vehicles, MFBN would have concerns about people trying to donate any salvaged game to food banks. Any game that is donated to food banks is required to be commercially processed. Additionally, game should be handled properly and processed in a timely manner. It is uncertain how timely any game would be salvaged as permitted by this proposed bill.


