



Blackfoot Reservation: 1,500,000 acres

Need a Blackfeet Fish and Wildlife Conservation Permit for all outdoor recreational activities. Permit is subject to limitations within Blackfeet Fish and Wildlife rules and regulations. One needs this permit to be permitted for other outdoor activities.

Flathead Reservation: 1,200,000 million acres

Special Permit Required. Need a joint state license and Flathead Reservation Stamp

Crow Reservation: 2,300,000 million acres

Special Permit Required.

Fort Belknap Reservation: 650,000 acres

Special Permit Required. Members and Non-member tags differ greatly in price depending on what game is desired to hunt. There is also a limited number of tags.

Fort Peck Reservation: 2,000,000 plus acres

Special Permit Required. One needs a conservation license and appropriate stamp in order to hunt within the boundaries of the reservation. They are also subject to more regulations found on at the following link. <http://www.fortpecktribes.org/fgd/hunting.htm>
