12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATU	JRE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

14	NEW SECTION. Section 1.	Article XIII of The Constitution of the State of Montana is amended by
15	adding a new section 8 that reads:	
16	Section 8. Abortion. Nothing in this constitution grants or secures a right to abortion or the public	
17	funding of abortion.

19	NEW SECTION. Section 2.	Two-thirds vote required. Because [section 1] is a legislative proposal
20	to amend the constitution, Article XIV, section 8, of the Montana constitution requires an affirmative roll call vote	
21	of two-thirds of all the members of the legislature, whether one or more bodies, for passage.

23	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. If approved by the electorate, [this act] is effective January	
24	1, 2015.

26	NEW SECTION. Section 4. Submission to electorate. [This act] shall be submitted to the qualified	
27	electors of Montana at the general election to be held in November 2014 by printing on the ballot the full title of	
28	[this act] and the following:
