



AN ACT ABOLISHING THE DRUG ABUSE RESISTANCE EDUCATION (D.A.R.E.) PROGRAM; ABOLISHING THE D.A.R.E. TRUST FUND ACCOUNT, THE VOLUNTARY INCOME TAX CHECKOFF, AND PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION THROUGH THE MONTANA BOARD OF CRIME CONTROL; PROVIDING FOR THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS REMAINING IN THE TRUST FUND ACCOUNT TO THE GENERAL FUND; REPEALING SECTIONS 44-2-701, 44-2-702, 44-2-703, 44-2-704, AND 44-2-705, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Repealer. The following sections of the Montana Code Annotated are repealed:

- 44-2-701. Montana drug abuse resistance education trust fund account -- administration by board of crime control.
- 44-2-702. Montana drug abuse resistance education program.
- 44-2-703. Gifts and grants to program.
- 44-2-704. Program costs.
- 44-2-705. Restriction on use of funds.

Section 2. Transfer of funds. All uncommitted funds remaining in the drug abuse resistance education trust fund account provided for in 44-2-701 on June 30, 2013, must be transferred to the state general fund on July 1, 2013.

Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
