5 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ABOLISHING THE DRUG ABUSE RESISTANCE EDUCATION  
6 (D.A.R.E.) PROGRAM; ABOLISHING THE D.A.R.E. TRUST FUND ACCOUNT, THE VOLUNTARY INCOME  
7 TAX CHECKOFF, AND PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION THROUGH THE MONTANA BOARD OF CRIME  
8 CONTROL; PROVIDING FOR THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS REMAINING IN THE TRUST FUND ACCOUNT TO  
9 THE GENERAL FUND; REPEALING SECTIONS 44-2-701, 44-2-702, 44-2-703, 44-2-704, AND 44-2-705, MCA;  
10 AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

14 NEW SECTION. **Section 1. Repealer.** The following sections of the Montana Code Annotated are  
15 repealed:

- 16 44-2-701. Montana drug abuse resistance education trust fund account -- administration by board of crime
- 17 control.
- 18 44-2-702. Montana drug abuse resistance education program.
- 19 44-2-703. Gifts and grants to program.
- 20 44-2-704. Program costs.
- 21 44-2-705. Restriction on use of funds.

23 NEW SECTION. **Section 2. Transfer of funds.** All uncommitted funds remaining in the drug abuse  
24 resistance education trust fund account provided for in 44-2-701 on June 30, 2013, must be transferred to the  
25 state general fund on July 1, 2013.

27 NEW SECTION. **Section 3. Effective date.** [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
