

SENATE BILL NO. 366

INTRODUCED BY R. ARTHUN

BY REQUEST OF THE SENATE STATE ADMINISTRATION STANDING COMMITTEE

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ELIMINATING THE LIMITATION ON THE NUMBER OF YEARS THAT A MEMBER OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY COUNCIL MAY SERVE; AMENDING SECTION 5-16-103, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 5-16-103, MCA, is amended to read:

"5-16-103. Term of office. The terms of office of all council members ~~shall be~~ are 2 years and shall terminate upon appointment of a new council before the 50th legislative day. Council members may be reappointed. ~~However, in no case shall a member serve more than 6 years.~~"

NEW SECTION. **Section 2. Effective date.** [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
