Dear Speaker Knudsen and President Barrett:

In accordance with the power vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and the laws of the State of Montana, I hereby veto House Bill 587 (HB 587), "AN ACT REQUIRING THAT CERTAIN MEDICAL PRACTITIONERS BE PHYSICALLY PRESENT WHEN PERFORMING OR PROVIDING CERTAIN ABORTION SERVICES TO A PREGNANT WOMAN; AND PROVIDING A PENALTY."

As a father, husband, and son, I stand firmly opposed to restrictions on a woman's ability to make deeply personal medical decisions in consultation with her medical provider, family members, and spiritual leaders. As elected officials, we should all be working together to expand access to health care services in Montana. Unfortunately, House Bill 587 and several other bills proposed this session seek to do just the opposite, particularly for women and families living in the more rural parts of our state.

HB 587 does more than just restrict access to health care; it would actually criminalize medical professionals for using their best medical judgment in providing safe and legal prescriptions via telemedicine. As a safe, effective, and efficient method of delivering health care to underserved regions of Montana, we should be embracing the use of telemedicine, not criminalizing it. I join the Montana Section of the American Congress of Obstetricians and Gynecologists in opposing HB 587 as an "unprecedented burden on Montana's physicians and patients."


Furthermore, as the Legislature's own staff has noted, HB 587 raises serious constitutional issues by infringing on women's right to privacy as guaranteed in the Montana Constitution.
