4 A RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA NOT CONCURRING IN, CONFIRMING, OR  
5 CONSENTING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF THE COMMISSIONER OF POLITICAL PRACTICES MADE BY THE  
6 GOVERNOR.

8 WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Montana has, in a May 20, 2013, letter to the Secretary of State,  
9 appointed Mr. Jonathan Motl to serve as the Commissioner of Political Practices, in accordance with sections  
10 13-37-102 and 13-37-104, MCA, to a term ending January 1, 2017; and

11 WHEREAS, Article VI, section 8, of the Montana Constitution outlines the Governor's appointment power;  
12 and

13 WHEREAS, section 13-37-102, MCA, states that the Governor's appointment of the Commissioner of  
14 Political Practices is subject to Senate confirmation.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

17 That the Senate of the Regular Session of the 64th Legislature of the State of Montana does hereby not  
18 concur in, confirm, or consent to the appointment of Jonathan Motl as the Commissioner of Political Practices  
19 and that the Secretary of the Senate immediately deliver a copy of this resolution to the Secretary of State and  
20 to the Governor.
