Description of fiscal impact: SB 275 has no fiscal impact to the state.

FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions:

1. The Constitution of the State of Montana requires that the Governor appoints and the Senate confirms the seven members of the Board of Public Education.
2. SB 275 proposes a constitutional amendment to have the seven members elected by the people. This requires a constitutional vote in the November 2016 election.
3. The Secretary of State estimates there would be no state cost to put this legislative referendum on the ballot.

Effect on County or Other Local Revenues or Expenditures:

1. The average cost to counties for ballots, printing, programming, and other associated costs are estimated to be \$28,069 to put this referendum on the ballot.
