





Limit Look-back for Homeowners Insurance

SB 84 • Protection from unreasonable non-renewal practices

Look-back Provisions in Other States

Alabama: Cannot use “acts of God” for cancellation, non-renewal or premium increase.

Louisiana: 5 year limit and must have two claims within three years to non-renew or increase deductible.

Maryland: 3 year limit.

Michigan: 3 year limit.

Minnesota (by rule): Cannot use losses from natural causes.

North Dakota: 5 year limit for wind and hail, 10 years for all other claims.

Oregon: 5 year limit.

Rhode Island: Can never use catastrophic events.

South Carolina: 3 year limit on non-renewals.

Texas: 3 year limit for non-renewals and raising premium.
