**instruction.** (1) If both House Bill No. 2 and [this act] are passed and approved and House Bill No. 2 contains a general fund appropriation that would allow the department of justice to increase the staff of the office of the child and family ombudsman, then the appropriation in House Bill No. 2 must be reduced by \$85,741 in each year of the biennium and \$85,741 in general fund must be transferred in each year of the biennium from the department of public health and human services to the department of justice to increase the staff of the ombudsman office.

(2) If both House Bill No. 2 and [this act] are passed and approved and House Bill No. 2 does not contain an appropriation to increase the staff of the office of the child and family ombudsman, then \$85,741 in general fund must be transferred from the department of public health and human services to the department of justice in each year of the biennium to increase the staff for the office."
