Testimony on HJ 4

A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA APPLYING TO CONGRESS TO CALL A CONVENTION FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF PROPOSING FOR RATIFICATION AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION REQUIRING A BALANCED FEDERAL BUDGET.

Mr. Chairman and members of the Judiciary committee, my name is Roger Nummerdor and I live in Absarokee MT. I am here today to ask you to vote against this resolution.

Today you have heard from many people as to why this resolution should pass.
