**UNBORN INDIAN CHILDREN DON'T HAVE ANY CIVIL RIGHTS  
IN MONTANA!**

Actually, no unborn children have an civil rights in Montana.

In 1995 HB 442 was passed to amend § 37-20-103, MCA (a portion of the Montana Code regulating physician assistants-certified), and § 50-20-109, MCA, to specifically exclude physician assistants-certified from performing abortions.

In 1999 the Montana Supreme Court ruled that HB 442 violated women's right to privacy and declared it unconstitutional under the Montana Constitution.

Thus, Indians, blacks, Hispanics, and all other unborn babies in Montana do not have any civil rights and can be killed at will.

I understand some of the legislators on this committee campaigned saying they were for abortions being few and infrequent. I can understand such a position; but when we allow over 2000 unborn babies to be killed in Montana each year we are not succeeding in making abortions few and infrequent.

Let us give civil rights to unborn babies in Montana. Indian, black, white and all! Let us give them personhood!
