Following: "insurer."

Insert: "However, prior authorization required under this subsection is not required for inpatient or emergency treatments."

2. Page 2, line 10.

Strike: "a pharmacist may not dispense"

Insert: "medications may not be dispensed for"

Explanation - Amendment #1 was requested by Senator Buttrey to clarify that prior authorization is not required for emergency treatments. This amendment addresses a technical note addressed in the fiscal note. Amendment #2 was requested by State Fund to clarify that compounds are prepared by physicians and not just pharmacies.
