1. Title, page 1, line 9.

Following: "REPRESENTATIVE;"**Insert:** "PROVIDING THAT IF AN ELECTION TO FILL AN UNEXPIRED TERM
AND AN ELECTION FOR A NEW TERM ARE HELD CONCURRENTLY, EACH
ELECTION MUST APPEAR SEPARATELY ON THE BALLOT;"

2. Page 1, line 17.

Strike: ", except as provided in subsection (3)"

3. Page 2, line 1 through line 3.

Strike: subsection (3) in its entirety**Insert:** "(3) If the election to fill the vacancy is held with
the federal general election in the final year of the term
to be filled, the election to fill the remainder of the
vacancy and the election to fill the upcoming term must be
placed on the ballot as separate issues. The candidate
elected to fill the unexpired term shall take office
immediately upon the certification of election results."

Explanation - This amendment requires that if an election for a vacancy in either the office of US Senate or US House of Representatives occurs in the last year of the term and the election is required to be held concurrently with the federal general election, the election for the remainder of the vacancy must appear as a separate matter on the ballot. This replaces current law, which requires that a candidate who wins the upcoming term for a US House of Representatives seat immediately takes office to fill both the unexpired term and the upcoming term.
