12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONT	ANA:

14	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Appropriations from school	facility and technology state special	
15	revenue account. (1) There is appropriated to the department of commerce \$5,881,000 from the school facility		
16	and technology state special revenue account to be used to finance grants authorized by this section.		
17	(2) The funds appropriated in subsection (1) must be used b	by the department to make grants to the	
18	public school districts listed in subsection (3) for the described purposes and in amounts not to exceed the		
19	amounts set out in subsection (3). The appropriation is subject to the conditions set forth in 90-6-812 and		
20	described in the quality schools facility grant program 2017 bienni	um report to the 64th legislature. The	
21	department shall commit funds to projects listed in subsection (3), up to	to the amounts authorized, based on the	
22	manner of disbursement set forth in subsections (4) through (6), until	the funds appropriated in subsection (1)	
23	are expended.		
24	(3) The following applicants and projects are authorized for gra	ants and listed in the order of their priority:

4 (4) A grant recipient's entitlement to receive funds is dependent on the grant recipient's compliance with 5 the conditions set forth in 90-6-812 and on the availability of funds.

6 (5) Funding for projects in subsection (3) will be provided only as long as there are sufficient funds
7 available from the school facility and technology state special revenue account. Funding for these projects will
8 be made available in the order that the grant recipients satisfy the conditions in 90-6-812.

9 (6) Grants to recipients listed in subsection (3) that have not completed all of the conditions described 10 in 90-6-812 by September 30, 2016, must be reviewed by the next regular session of the legislature to determine 11 if the authorized grant should be withdrawn.

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Approval of grants -- completion of biennial appropriation. The legislature, pursuant to 90-6-809 and 90-6-810, approves the quality schools facility grants listed in [section 1] and for the purposes in [sections 4 and 5]. The authorization of these grants completes a biennial appropriation from the school facility and technology state special revenue account provided for in 20-9-516.

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18 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 3. Condition of grants -- disbursement of funds. The disbursement of grant
 19 funds for the projects specified in [section 1(3)] is subject to the conditions set forth in 90-6-812.

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21 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 4. Appropriation from school facility and technology state special 22 revenue account for emergency grants. There is appropriated to the department of commerce \$100,000 for 23 the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, from the school facility and technology state special revenue account for 24 the purpose of providing emergency grants to public school districts for a school facility project that is 25 necessitated by an emergency, as defined in 90-6-803.

- 27 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 5. Appropriation from school facility and technology state special 28 revenue account for planning grants. There is appropriated to the department of commerce \$900,000 for the 29 biennium beginning July 1, 2015, from the school facility and technology state special revenue account for the 30 purpose of providing matching planning grants to public school districts for the planning of school facility projects,

3	NEW SECTION. Section 6. Notification to tribal governments. The secretary of state shall send a
4	copy of [this act] to each tribal government located on the seven Montana reservations and to the Little Shell
5	Chippewa tribe.

7	NEW SECTION. Section 7. Effective date. [This act] is effective July 1, 2015.
