6	OR FRAUD; AMENDING SECTION 26-1-803, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
9	
10	Section 1. Section 26-1-803, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"26-1-803. Attorney-client privilege. (1) An attorney cannot, without the consent of the client, be
12	examined as to any communication made by the client to the attorney or the advice given to the client in the
13	course of professional employment.
14	(2) A client cannot, except voluntarily, be examined as to any communication made by the client to the
15	client's attorney or the advice given to the client by the attorney in the course of the attorney's professional
16	employment.
17	(3) There is no privilege under this section if the services of the attorney were sought or obtained to
18	enable or aid anyone to commit or plan to commit a crime or fraud."

20	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
