A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ~~PROVIDING THAT~~ ALLOWING A PETITIONER THAT PERSON
WHO PREVAILS AND OBTAINS RELIEF AT ANY STAGE IN AN ACTION TO ENFORCE THE
CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE ~~IS TO BE~~ AWARDED COSTS AND REASONABLE ATTORNEY
FEES; AMENDING SECTION 2-3-114, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE AND AN
APPLICABILITY DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 2-3-114, MCA, is amended to read:

"2-3-114. Enforcement. (1) The district courts of the state have jurisdiction to set aside an agency
decision under this part upon petition of any person whose rights have been prejudiced. A petition pursuant to
this section must be filed within 30 days of the date on which the ~~petitioner~~ PERSON learns, or reasonably should
have learned, of the agency's decision.

(2) A ~~petitioner~~ PERSON ALLEGING A DEPRIVATION OF RIGHTS who prevails and obtains relief at any stage
in an action brought in district court to enforce the ~~petitioner's~~ PERSON'S rights under Article II, section 8, of the
Montana constitution must MAY be awarded costs and reasonable attorney fees."

NEW SECTION. **Section 2. Effective date.** [This act] is effective on passage and approval.

NEW SECTION. **Section 3. Applicability.** [This act] applies to proceedings initiated on or after [the
effective date of this act].
