9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Immunity for employer for misuse of firearm. A private sector employer
12	that does not have or enforce a policy prohibiting employees from keeping a firearm out of sight and locked in
13	an employee's vehicle at the employer's workplace may not be held liable for any incident, injury, or damages
14	resulting from a firearm being taken from an employee's motor vehicle parked at the employee's workplace."

16	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
17	integral part of Title 27, chapter 1, part 7, and the provisions of Title 27, chapter 1, part 7, apply to [section 1].
