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| 9 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: |
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| 11 | NEW SECTION. Section 1. Enabling Act enforcement findings. (1) The legislature finds that: |
| 12 | (a) section 13 of The Enabling Act requires that 5% of the proceeds from public lands in Montana sold |
| 13 | by the United States, after deduction of expenses, must be paid to the state for the support of the common |
| 14 | schools; |
| 15 | (b) the United States incorrectly interprets The Enabling Act provision cited in subsection (1)(a) to only |
| 16 | include the sale of lands managed by the secretary of the interior; and |
| 17 | (c) the United States owes Montana 5% of the proceeds of all public land in Montana sold by the United |
| 18 | States government since November 8, 1889. |
| 19 | (2) The attorney general shall pursue, TO THE EXTENT FEASIBLE USING AVAILABLE STATE RESOURCES, |
| 20 | payment of the funds owed to Montana pursuant to subsection (1). |
| 21 | (3) Any money paid to the state pursuant to this section must be deposited in the permanent fund for the |
| 22 | support of common schools as referenced in section 13 of The Enabling Act. |
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| 24 | NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an |
| 25 | integral part of Title 77, chapter 1, part 1, and the provisions of Title 77, chapter 1, part 1, apply to [section 1]. |
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| 27 | NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval. |
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
