

SENATE BILL NO. 379

INTRODUCED BY G. VANCE

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A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REVISING LAWS TO REQUIRE THE STATE FUND TO SUBMIT A REPORT ON ITS BUDGET TO THE ECONOMIC AFFAIRS INTERIM COMMITTEE; AMENDING SECTION 5-5-223, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 5-5-223, MCA, is amended to read:

"5-5-223. Economic affairs interim committee. (1) The economic affairs interim committee has administrative rule review, draft legislation review, program evaluation, and monitoring functions for the following executive branch agencies and the entities attached to agencies for administrative purposes:

- ~~(1)~~(a) department of agriculture;
- ~~(2)~~(b) department of commerce;
- ~~(3)~~(c) department of labor and industry;
- ~~(4)~~(d) department of livestock;
- ~~(5)~~(e) office of the state auditor and insurance commissioner;
- ~~(6)~~(f) office of economic development;
- ~~(7)~~(g) the state compensation insurance fund provided for in 39-71-2313, including the board of directors of the state compensation insurance fund established in 2-15-1019; and
- ~~(8)~~(h) the division of banking and financial institutions provided for in 32-1-211.

(2) The state compensation insurance fund must annually provide a report on its budget as approved by the state compensation insurance fund board of directors to the committee."

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.

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
