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11	Section 1. Section 70-30-313, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"70-30-313. Current fair market value. Current fair market value is the price that would be agreed to
13	by a willing and informed seller and buyer, taking into consideration, but not limited to, the following factors:
14	(1) the highest and best reasonably available use and its value for such use, provided current use may
15	not be presumed to be the highest and best use;
16	(2) the price paid for other comparable easements or leases of comparable type, size, and location or
17	the same or similar property;
18	(2)(3) the machinery, equipment, and fixtures forming part of the real estate taken; and
19	(3)(4) any other relevant factors <del>as to</del> <u>for</u> which evidence is offered."

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23	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Applicability. [This act] applies to eminent domain proceedings initiated
24	on or after [the effective date of this act].
