4	A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF
5	MONTANA URGING PROMPT CONGRESSIONAL AND PRESIDENTIAL APPROVAL FOR THE KEYSTONE
6	XL PIPELINE.

8	WHEREAS, the state of Montana, counties, and school districts will benefit substantially by an increase
9	in the property tax base when the Keystone XL Pipeline is approved and completed; and
10	WHEREAS, the Certificate of Compliance granted by the Department of Environmental Quality in 2012
11	for the Keystone XL Pipeline states that "the Project will generate long-term property tax revenues for the
12	counties traversed by the pipeline that will last for the life of the Project. The Project will generate approximately
13	\$63 million in annual property tax revenues in Montana"; and
14	WHEREAS, the selected location of the pipeline through Montana and the conditions imposed by the
15	Certificate of Compliance granted by the Department of Environmental Quality minimize adverse impacts on the
16	environment, landowners, and affected communities; and
17	WHEREAS, significant infrastructure improvements, including powerlines and road and bridge
18	improvements, will be built and paid for by TC Energy; and
19	WHEREAS, Montana's Congressional Delegation supports the approval of the pipeline; and
20	WHEREAS, Montana's Governor Greg Gianforte supports approval of the pipeline.

22	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
23	THE STATE OF MONTANA:
24	That the 67th Legislature urge prompt congressional and presidential approval for the Keystone XL
25	Pipeline.
26	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State send copies of this resolution to the
27	President of the United States, the Majority Leader of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the United
28	States House of Representatives, and the Montana Congressional Delegation.
