| 12 | Except as provided in subsection (2), a person under 18 years of age shall-may not be employed as a |
| 13 | bartender, waiter, or waitress whose duty is to serve customers purchasing liquors, beer, or wines in any |
| 14 | establishment which sells liquors, beer, or wines at retail. |
| 15 | (2) A person who is 16 or 17 years of age may be employed as a waiter or waitress whose duty is to |
| 16 | serve customers purchasing liquors, beer, or wines if written consent is provided by the person's parent or legal |
| 17 | guardian. The consent may be withdrawn at any time. |
| 18 | (2)(3) Any retail vendor of liquors, beer, or wines who employs any such person under the age of 18 |
| 19 | years is guilty of a misdemeanor." |
