| 5 | MONTANA PROCLAIMING THE MONTH OF MAY AS AMYOTROPHIC LATERAL SCLEROSIS (ALS) |
| 6 | AWARENESS MONTH AND URGING THE PRESIDENT AND CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES TO |
| 7 | ENACT LEGISLATION TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR RESEARCH IN ORDER TO FIND A |
| 8 | TREATMENT AND A CURE FOR AMYOTROPHIC LATERAL SCLEROSIS. |

| 10 | WHEREAS, amyotrophic lateral sclerosis or ALS is better known as Lou Gehrig's disease; and |
| 11 | WHEREAS, ALS is a fatal neurodegenerative disease characterized by degeneration of cell bodies of |
| 12 | the lower motor neurons in the gray matter of the anterior horns of the spinal cord; and |
| 13 | WHEREAS, the initial symptom of ALS is weakness of the skeletal muscles, especially those of the |
| 14 | extremities; and |
| 15 | WHEREAS, as ALS progresses the patient experiences difficulty in swallowing, talking, and breathing; |
| 16 | and |
| 17 | WHEREAS, ALS eventually causes muscles to atrophy, and the patient becomes a functional |
| 18 | quadriplegic; and |
| 19 | WHEREAS, ALS does not affect a patient's mental capacity, and the patient remains alert and aware of |
| 20 | the loss of motor functions and the inevitable outcome of continued deterioration and death; and |
| 21 | WHEREAS, on average, patients diagnosed with ALS only survive 2 to 5 years from the time of |
| 22 | diagnosis; and |
| 23 | WHEREAS, ALS has no known cause, means of prevention, or cure; and |
| 24 | WHEREAS, research indicates that military veterans are approximately twice as likely to develop ALS |
| 25 | as those who have not served in the military; and |
| 26 | WHEREAS, the Department of Veterans Affairs implemented regulations to establish a presumption of |
| 27 | service connection for ALS, thereby presuming that the development of ALS was incurred or aggravated by a |
| 28 | veteran's service in the military; and |

| 1 | WHEREAS, a national ALS patient registry, administered by the Centers for Disease Control and |
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| 2 | Prevention, is currently identifying cases of ALS in the United States and may become the single largest ALS |
| 3 | research project ever created; and |
| 4 | WHEREAS, Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis Awareness Month increases the public's awareness of ALS |
| 5 | patients' circumstances and acknowledges the terrible impact this disease has not only on the patient but on his |
| 6 | or her family and the community and recognizes the research being done to eradicate this horrible disease. |

| 8 | NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF |
| 9 | THE STATE OF MONTANA: |
| 10 | That the Legislature hereby proclaims the month of May each year as Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis |
| 11 | Awareness Month in Montana. |
| 12 | BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislature urges the President and Congress of the United |
| 13 | States to enact legislation to provide additional funding for research in order to find a treatment and eventually a |
| 14 | cure for amyotrophic lateral sclerosis. |
| 15 | BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State send a copy of this resolution to the governor |
| 16 | of Montana, the Montana congressional delegation, the majority and minority leaders of the United States |
| 17 | Senate and House of Representatives, and the President of the United States. |
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
