9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	Section 1. Section 39-3-409, MCA, is amended to read:	
12	"39-3-409. Adoption of minimum wage rates exception. (1) The minimum wage, except as	
13	provided in subsection (3), must be the greater of either:	
14	(a) the minimum hourly wage rate as provided under the federal Fair Labor Standards Act of 19	938
15	(29 U.S.C. 206(a)(1)), excluding the value of tips received by the employee and the special provisions for a	
16	raining wage; or	
17	(b) \$\frac{\\$6.15}{11.39}\$ an hour, excluding the value of tips received by the employee and the specia	I
18	provisions for a training wage.	
19	(2) (a) The minimum wage is subject to a cost-of-living adjustment, as provided in subsection	
20	(2)(b).	
21	(b) No later than September 30 of each year, an adjustment of the wage amount specified in	
22	subsection (1) must be made based upon on the increase, if any, from August of the preceding year to Aug	ust
23	of the year in which the calculation is made in the consumer price index, U.S. city average, all urban	
24	consumers, for all items, as published by the bureau of labor statistics of the United States department of la	bor
25	(c) The wage amount established under this subsection (2):	
26	(i) must be rounded to the nearest 5 cents; and	
27	(ii) becomes effective as the new minimum wage, replacing the dollar figure specified in	
28	subsection (1), on January 1 of the following year.
