12	(2) (a) Noncustodial obligo	rs shall cooperate with the department's child support enforcement
13	services provided for in 40-5-203 as a condition of eligibility for the federal supplemental nutrition assistance	
14	program in accordance with the provisions of 7 CFR 273.11(o) and 7 CFR 273.11(p).	
15	(b) An individual is not elig	ible for the supplemental nutrition assistance program during any month
16	in which the individual is delinquent in payment of a support order, as that term is defined in 40-5-201.	
17	(3) The department shall e	xempt from the requirement described in subsection (1) obligors:
18	(a) who provide good caus	e for not cooperating, as allowed under 7 CFR 273.11(o); or
19	(b) whose noncooperation	is not determined to be a refusal to cooperate, as described in 7
20	CFR 273.11(p).
