10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12	Section 1. Section 87-6-222, MCA, is amended to read:
13	"87-6-222. Fish and wildlife location data penalties. (1) Unless specifically authorized by the
14	department, a person who obtains exact coordinate location data from the department may not use the data or
15	transfer the data to another person to use in a way that harms, harasses, or kills fish or wildlife. A person who
16	uses, transfers, or receives exact coordinate location data in violation of this section shall be fined not less than
17	\$50 or more than \$1,000 or be imprisoned in the county detention center for not more than 6 months, or both.
18	(2) A person may not sell images, video, or location data of wildlife located on public land that is
19	obtained by a device triggered by heat or motion for use in a way that harms, harasses, or kills fish or wildlife.
20	(3) A person convicted of violating subsections (1) or (2) shall be fined not less than \$50 or more
21	than \$1,000 or be imprisoned in the county detention center for not more than 6 months, or both.
22	(2)(4) Upon On conviction or forfeiture of bond or bail, the person may be subject to forfeiture of any
23	current hunting, fishing, or trapping license issued by this state and the privilege to hunt, fish, or trap in this
24	state or to use state lands, as defined in 77-1-101, for recreational purposes for a period of time set by the
25	court.
26	(3)(5) A person convicted under this section may be subject to the additional penalties provided in 87
27	6-901 through 87-6-903.
28	(4)(6) A violation of this section may also result in an order to pay restitution pursuant to 87-6-905
